CH 42 or 10+2

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH. RPT [SK 4 CHs, 11 TR in next CH. SK 4 CHs. 1 SC in next CH] across. Turn.

ROW 2: CH 4, TR in first ST (top of last SC made). RPT [CH 4, SC in 6th TR. CH 4, TR-CL above SC] across. Turn.

ROW 3: CH 4. 5 TR in first ST (top of last TR-CL made). RPT [SC above SC, 11 TR above next TR-CL] across, ending with SC above last SC, and 6 TR above last TR-CL. Turn.

ROW 4: CH 1, SC in first ST. RPT [CH 4, TR-CL above SC, CH 4, SC in 6th TR] across, ending with the SC on top of CH-4. Turn.

ROW 5: CH 1, SC in first ST. RPT [11 TR above TR-CL, SC above SC] across. Turn.

RPT ROWs 2-5 until desired height.
