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## DIY Lace Bowl and Basket from a Doily

Learn how to make a lace bowl and basket from a doily in this DIY tutorial. It is a great recycling or upcycling project! ## Materials:

Any thread or yarn-based doily will work. Size does not matter. Plastic containers, cups, margarine tubs, pots, pans, etc. to serve as a mold. This mold will be used to shape the doily as it is drying. 3-4 ounces of glue per doily. 3-4 ounces of water per doily. Gloves to protect your hands. Plastic wrap to cover the containers.

Step 1: Find a doily. This can be any crochet, knitted, or tatted one.

Step 2: Find a corresponding plastic container to serve as a mold. You will usually turn this bowl or container upside down.

Step 3: Place plastic wrap over the mold to protect the mold and to make it easier to lift the doily off once dried.

Step 4: Prepare 3 ounces of glue with 2 or 3 ounces of water in a plastic craft container. Stir to combine the mixture. Try to break up any glue clumps.

Step 5: Place the doily directly in the glue-water mixture. Allow it to become completely saturated with the liquid mixture.

Step 6: Do not wring the doily out. Place it on top of the plastic wrap, which is on top of your mold. Don't worry about any drips that might fall on the plastic wrap.

Step 7: Smooth out the sizes and pay particular attention to the edges. Feel free to pour on, then smear a bit more glue-water mixture with gloved hands around the doily if needed.

Step 8: Wait 24 hours or more until the doily completely dries.

Step 9: Gently pry the doily away from the plastic wrap and bowl.
