
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## Solomon's Knot Scarf (Crochet)

The Crochet Solomon's Knot Scarf is a lovely, lightweight scarf made with the love knot stitch that can be used any time of the year. Terminology:		
CH = Chain	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
SMKT = Solomon's Knot	ST = Stitch	
Size/Gauge:		

Size/Gauge can vary due to stretchiness of stitch. Size: 7" W x 36" L. Gauge: 5 KNOTS & 5 ROWs = 4" SQ.

## Materials:

60 yards of DK weight yarn. Sample used Bernat Softee Baby Cotton in Feather Gray. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Yarn needle, scissors.

## Instructions:

ROW 1: CH 2. SC in 2nd CH from hook. Make 7 SMKTs across (or any odd multiple). Prior to turning, make 3 SMKTs. Turn.

ROW 2: SC into 5th SC from hook. RPT [Make 2 SMKTs, skip 1 SC, SC in next SC] across. TIP: You will make SCs in SCs that have no other SCs in them. Prior to turning, make 3 SMKTs. Turn.

Continue repeating ROW 2 for 36 inches, or desired length. Fasten off, weave in ends. Block if desired.
