# Size/Gauge:

Flower has a diameter of 3.5". Gauge is not important.

### **Materials:**

30 yards worsted weight yarn. Sample used 100% cotton scrap yarn. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Yarn needle, scissors. Optional floral stem and hot glue.

# **ROSE FLOWER**

CH 62.

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook. RPT [CH 2. Skip 1 CH, 1 DC in next 2 CHs. CH 2. Skip 1 CH, SC in next CH] across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: SC in SC. RPT [CH 3. 2 DC in between previous 2 DC. CH 3. SC in SC] across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: SC in SC. RPT [In between previous 2 DC: 4 DC, PICOT, 4 DC. SC in SC] across. Fasten off, leaving a 12" tail end.

Roll strip along CH edge to from a flower. Using the tail end, sew and pierce through all layers several times along the CH edge to hold flower together. Fasten off, weave in ends.

# **LEAVES**

CH 9.

SIDE 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook. HDC in next CH. DC in next 4 CHs. HDC in next CH. SC in last CH. SC along edge. Pivot to work on other side of CH. SC in first CH, HDC in next CH. DC in next 4 CHs. HDC in next CH. SC in last CH. SLST to first ST. Fasten off, leaving an 8" tail end if sewing to flower. Or weave in ends if gluing.

# **FINISH**

Use flower and leaves as a corsage or a bouquet. For a corsage, sew leaves to flower. For a stem or stick, arrange then hot glue flower and leaves.
