



# Crosshatch Stitch (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The crosshatch stitch is a good stitch for a blanket, scarf, shawl, hat, and more. Sometimes known as the box stitch or block stitch. After you try it, you might find it reminds you of the C2C stitch (corner to corner) but made in a row! Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

## Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST = Stitch

CH 49 (multiple of 7)

ROW 1: 2 DC in 3rd CH from hook. Skip 3 CHs, SLST in next CH. RPT [CH 3. 1 DC in next 3 CHs. Skip 3 CHs, SLST in next CH] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: 2 DC in base of CH-3. SLST in next CH-3 SP. RPT [CH 3. 3 DC in CH-3 SP. SLST in next CH-3 SP] across. At the end, SLST into top of previous ROW's turning CH instead. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3+: RPT ROW 2.
