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Pansy Flower (Crochet)

A pansy is a unique looking flower. This crochet version is quick and easy to make. Plus, these pansies are very colorful! Terminology:		
CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	HDC = Half Double Crochet
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch
ST = Stitch	TR = Treble Crochet	
Size/Gauge:		
Flower is 3.5" W x 2.5" H. Gauge is not important.		
Materials:		
15 yards of worsted weight yarn (total). Sample blue flower used I Love This Yarn in		
Soft Blue, Medium Blue, and Lemon Ice. Small amount of brown thread, floss, or		
yarn. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Scissors, yarn needle. Optional bling and glue.

With yellow –		

CH 4. SLST to first CH to form ring. RND 1: CH 1. 8 SC in ring. SLST to first ST. Total = 8 STs. RND 2: CH 4. RPT [Skip 1 ST, SC in next ST] around. Total = 4 CH-4 rings. RND 3: RPT [SLST to CH-4 ring. CH 2. 6 DC in ring. CH 2. SLST in same ring] in all 4 rings.

RND 4: CH 10. Back-post SLST in between petals from RND 3. CH 10. Back-post SLST in between CH-4 rings from RND 2. Total = 2 CH-10 rings in the back of the flower. Fasten off, weave in ends.

With light blue -

RND 5: Place a slip knot on hook. Start at first petal with a CH-10 behind it. RPT for the next 2 petals: [SLST in between the CH-2 and DC. 2 HDC in same space. Make 1 DC in between DCs from RND 4. Total = 5 DC. In last space between last DC and CH-2, make 2 HDC. CH 2. SLST to same space]. Fasten off, but do not weave in ends.

With dark blue -

RND 6: Place a slip knot on hook. Start at first CH-10 ring. RPT for both CH-10 rings: [SLST in ring. CH 2. In ring, 1 DC, 8 TR, 1 DC, CH 2. SLST in ring]. Fasten off, but do not weave in ends.

Take the two blue ends and tie/knot them along both sides to secure the petals together, then weave in ends.

With brown yarn, sew a decorative center part. Glue or sew on bling in the center if desired.
