Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

PREV = Previous

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST = Stitch

E-DC-CL = Elongated Double Crochet Cluster

SHELL = 2 DC, CH 1, 2 DC

Instructions:

With PURPLE yarn, CH 40 or any multiple of 5.

ROW 1: DC in 4th CH from hook. RPT [Skip 4 CHs, SHELL in next CH] across until last 6 CHs. Skip 4 CHs, DC in last 2 CHs. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: (turning CH-3 counts as a DC throughout). DC in DC. RPT [SHELL in CH-1 of previous SHELL] across until last 2 STs. DC in last 2 STs. Change to PINK yarn. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3: DC in DC. RPT [E-DC-CL in SP from 2 ROWs below. SHELL in CH-1 of previous SHELL. E-DC-CL in SP from 2 ROWs below] across until last 2 STs. DC in last 2 STs. CH 3, turn.

ROW 4: DC in DC. RPT [SHELL in CH-1 of previous SHELL] across until last 2 CHs. DC in last 2 CHs. CH 3, turn.

ROW 5: RPT ROW 4.

RPT ROWs 3-5, changing colors every 3 rows. Sample ended on a ROW 3.
