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Button Flower (Crochet)

This crochet button flower is quick, simple, and easy to make for a hat, scarf, shawl, bag, and more. These flowers consist of two rounds of crochet worked within buttonholes. Terminology:

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CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	DTR = Double Treble
HDC = Half Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	ST= Stitch	TR = Treble Crochet

Size/Gauge:

Instructions for 1.25" button (2.5" flower) with changes for .75" (1.5" flower) and 2"(3.5" flower). Gauge not important.

Materials:

Less than 10 yds of DK weight yarn for 1.25" and 2" button. 1 skein of embroidery floss for .75" button. Size C 2.75mm crochet hook, or any size that can fit through buttonholes. One button 1.25", .75" or 2". Optional clear nail polish or glue.

Instructions:

1.25" or .75" button. Changes for 2" button in (parentheses).

RND 1:

First buttonhole: Place slipknot on hook. Insert into any buttonhole and make a SC. CH 4 (CH 5). Make a SC in same buttonhole. CH 4 (CH 5).

Second buttonhole. Make a SC into buttonhole. CH 4 (CH 5).

Third buttonhole: Make a SC in buttonhole. CH 4 (CH 5). Make another SC in buttonhole. CH 4 (CH 5).

Fourth buttonhole: Make a SC in buttonhole. CH 4 (CH 5). SLST to first ST.

RND 2: In each loop around, make the following:

SC, HDC, DC, TR, DC, HDC, SC. (SC, HDC, DC, TR, DTR, TR, DC, HDC, SC).

Once completed, SLST to first SC. Fasten off and weave in ends. Use the center buttonholes and matching or contrasting yarn/thread to attach to a hat, scarf, shawl, bag, and more.
