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Cross Over Stitch (Crochet)

This cross over stitch pattern is one of the nicest textured crochet stitches. It works up fast and is easy to make. Terminology:		
CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	ST= Stitch

Note: You can change the look of the stitch by adjusting the size of the long double crochet. If you pull up the yarn significantly, the three double crochet stitches will be held together loosely. If you pull up the yarn a bit less, the three double crochet stitches will be gathered tighter together.

CH 25 (or any multiple of 4+1)

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook. SC across. Total = 24 SC. Turn.

ROW 2: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). DC in next ST. RPT [Skip 1 ST, DC in next 3 STs. Make a long DC in skipped ST] across until last 2 STs. DC in last 2 STs. Turn.

ROW 3: CH 1. SC in each ST across. Total = 24 SC. Turn.

ROW 4: RPT ROW 2.

RPT ROWs 3-4 until desired height.
