



Basic Border Edgings (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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These three basic crochet borders work great for blankets and scarves and more, including the traditional, picture frame, and padded. Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

HDC = Half Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

ST= Stitch

Traditional

Place a slipknot on hook. Slip stitch to a top corner of the work. * CH 1. Make 3 HDC in first corner (Feel free to substitute HDC with another ST like SC, DC, or TR). Make 1 HDC along first side. Make 3 HDC in second corner. Make 1 HDC along second side. Make 3 HDC in third corner. Make 1 HDC along second side. Make 3 HDC in fourth corner. Make 1 HDC along second side. SLST to first ST.

Picture Frame

Place a slipknot on hook. Slip stitch to a top corner of the work. SLST evenly and loosely along entire work. SLST to first SLST, using the back loop. RPT starting from * in the Traditional border, using back loops only throughout.

Padded

Repeat Picture Frame for one side. Fasten off and weave in ends. Repeat Picture Frame for the back side. Once this side is complete, CH 1. Using both pieces of border edging held together, SC around, connecting the two pieces along their top edge.
