



# Crochet Hook Holder (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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This crochet hook holder is fast and easy to make with an icing container. This holder keeps your crochet hooks, scissors, stitch markers, yarn needles, and more in one place. ## Terminology:

CH = Chain

HDC = Half Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST = Stitch

## Size/Gauge:

Fits icing container 3.5" x 3.75". It is easy to accommodate other sizes. Gauge not important.

## Materials:

Icing container 3.5" x 3.75". 175 yds worsted weight yarn. G 4 mm crochet hook. Scissors. Yarn needle.

## INSIDE CONTAINER

With gray, make a slipknot, then CH 4. SLST to first CH to form a ring. CH 1.

RND 1: Within this ring, make 10 HDC. Work in spirals and back loops (no SLST).

RND 2: Make 2 HDC in each ST around. Mark first ST and work in spirals/blo again.

RND 3: Keep the bottom of the container near. RPT [2 HDC, 1 HDC] around, blo, until the crochet circle covers the bottom of the container. Sample needed 50 STs on this RND.

Begin working in ROWs. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 1: In the back loops only, make 1 HDC in each ST around, until you reach the first HDC made. Bend the crochet section down and note the unworked loops of the spiral. Make 1 HDC in each of these loops until you reach the center. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: Make 1 HDC, under both loops, in each ST of the spiral until you reach the outer section. CH 1, turn.

ROWs 3+: Continue working 1 HDC in each ST of the spiral. CH 1, turn.

Complete enough ROWs to fit the inside of the container with about ½ to 1 row spilling over the edge of the container. Fasten off and weave in ends.

### **OUTSIDE CONTAINER**

Begin working in RNDs.

RND 1: With a new color yarn, make a SC connecting the “break” in the work along the top edge of the container. Continue making 1 SC around the top edge. Work in spirals.

RND 2+: SC in each ST around, working in spirals.

Complete enough RNDs to fit the outside of the container. SLST to the next ST if working in RNDs to smooth the edging. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Place the finished work over the container. It should fit snugly. Then fill your hook holder with all sorts of goodies!
