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Cupcake (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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This crochet cupcake works great for holding sewing supplies like pins and needles. It also makes a cute gift and decoration for someone's birthday! Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

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BPDC = Back Post DC	CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet
FPDC = Front Post DC	FPSC = Front Post SC	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	ST= Stitch

Size/Gauge:

Size is 4" W x 3.5" H. Gauge is not important.

Materials:

125 yards worsted weight yarn. Sample used Red Heart Super Saver in Oatmeal and Perfect Pink. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Scissors, yarn needle, polyester stuffing, optional pom pom and beads or sewing pins for the sprinkles.

BASE

With oatmeal (brown), CH 4. SLST to form ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as DC). Make 14 DC in ring. SLST to first ST. Total = 15 DC

RND 2: CH 3 (counts as DC). Make 2 DC in each ST around. SLST to first ST. Total = 30 DC

RND 3: CH 1 (not a ST). BPDC around each ST. SLST to first ST. Total = 30 BPDC.

RNDs 4, 5, 6: CH 1 (not a ST). FPDC around each ST. SLST to first ST. After RND 6, do not SLST. Total = 30 FPDC.

RND 7: SLST to first ST using the front loops only. Make a FPSC. RPT [SLST to next ST using front loops, FPSC] around. SLST to first ST. Fasten off.

TOP

With perfect pink, CH 2. Feel free to substitute with a magic ring instead. We will be working in spirals throughout this section.

RND 1: Make 6 SC in the 2^{nd} CH from hook. Total = 6 SC.

RND 2: Make 2 SC in each ST around. Total = 12 SC.

RND 3: RPT [2 SC, 1 SC] in each ST around. Total = 18 SC.

RND 4: RPT [2 SC, SC, SC] in each ST around. Total = 24 SC.

RND 5: RPT [2 SC, SC, SC, SC] in each ST around. Total = 30 SC.

RNDs 6, 7, 8: SC in each ST around. Total = 30 SC on each RND.

RND 9: SLST to the next ST using front loops only. RPT [SC, DC in next ST, using front loops] around. SLST to first ST. Fasten off, leaving an 18" tail for sewing the TOP to the BASE.

FINISH

Sew or glue on any toppings to the TOP section at this time. Slowly fill some polyester fiber stuffing in the base and top, then sew along the edges. Use the back loops left over from RND 9 of the TOP section to connect to the inner loops of the BASE section.
