With Color A, CH 36 (multiple 10+6)

ROW 1: SC in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{CH}$ from hook and in each ST across. Turn.

ROW 2: CH 3 (counts as a DC). DC in each ST across. Turn.

ROW 3: CH 1 (not a ST). SC in each ST across. Do not turn. Fasten off Color A.

ROW 4: With Color B, place a slipknot on hook. Going in same direction as previous ROW, SC in first ST. SC in next 4 STs. RPT [Over next 5 STs: FPDC 1 ROW below,

FPDC 2 ROWs below, FPTR 2 ROWs below, FPDC 2 ROWs below, FPDC 1 ROW below. (Ensure you skip over the back of the 5 STs just made). SC in next 5 STs] across. Turn.

ROW 5: CH 3 (counts as a DC). DC over all SCs. Over the FPSTs, DC in first 2 FPSTs. Over $3^{\text {rd }}$ FPST, work the front loop of Color A into the DC to close the gap. DC in last 2 FPSTs. Continue with this process across. Turn.

ROW 6: CH 1 (not a ST). SC in each ST across. Do not turn. Fasten off Color B.

RPT ROWs 4-6, changing colors as desired.
