



Brick Stitch (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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This crochet brick stitch is a nice colorful textured pattern that consists of single crochet stitches and elongated stitches. It works great for a blanket, hat, scarf, shawl, bag, and more. Terminology:

CH = Chain

ESC = Elongated Single Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

ST= Stitch

Instructions:

With MORTAR-COLOR yarn, CH 30 (multiple of 4+2)

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: SC in each ST across. Change to BRICK-COLOR yarn. Do not cut MORTAR-COLOR yarn. CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 4: SC in each ST across. Change to MORTAR-COLOR yarn. Either carry the same BRICK-COLOR yarn along the sides or choose a new color for each BRICK-COLOR layer. CH 1, turn.

ROW 5: SC in first 2 STs. ESC. RPT [SC in next 3 ST, ESC] across, ending with SC in last 2 STs. CH 1, turn.

ROW 6: SC in each ST across. Change BRICK-COLOR. CH 1, turn.

ROW 7: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 8: SC in each ST across. Change to MORTAR-COLOR. CH 1, turn.

ROW 9: ESC in first ST. RPT [SC in next 3 ST, ESC] across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 10: SC in each ST across. Change to BRICK-COLOR. CH 1, turn.

RPT ROWs 3-10 for desired height.
