Terminology:		
CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	HDC = Half Double Crochet
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch
ST= Stitch		

POPCORN ST = 5 DC in same ST. Remove hook. Insert hook under first DC and pull through loop. CH 1.

Instructions:

White yarn will be carried throughout sample. Pink yarn will be carried behind only on its row. Same with green yarn. Color changes should occur on the previous stitch's final draw-through of yarn.

With white, CH 40 (multiple of 5).

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each ST across. CH 1, turn. (Total = 39 STs) ROW 2: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn. ROW 3: SC in each ST across, CH 1, turn. ROW 4: SC in first 4 STs. RPT [Add green yarn, carry white behind. SC in next ST. CH 5, SLST in same ST. CH 7, SLST in same ST. CH 5, SC in same ST. Change to white, carry green behind. SC in next 4 STs] across. At the end, fasten off green and continue with white. CH 1, turn.

ROW 5: Push all green leaves towards the back. SC in first 4 SCs. RPT [CH 1 across leaves, SC in next 4 SCs] across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 6: SC in each ST and CH-1 across. CH 1, turn. (Total = 39 STs)

ROW 7: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 8: SC in first 4 STs. RPT [Add pink yarn, carry white behind. Pull up CH-7 and make a POPCORN ST on the top of the ST from 2 ROWs below. Change to white, carry pink behind. SC in next 4 STs] across. At the end, fasten off pink and continue with white. CH 1, turn.

ROW 9: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 10: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn. (Total = 39 STs).

ROW 11: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

RPT ROWs 4-11 for pattern.
