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## Shell Scales Stitch (Crochet)

The crochet shell scales stitch pattern is fast and easy to make yet looks very pretty and interesting! This works great for a blanket, scarf, shawl, handbag, and more. 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Terminology:	
CH = Chain	RPT = Repeat

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SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch
TR = Treble Crochet		

## **Instructions:**

NOTE: We will CH 2 (instead of the typical CH 1) at the beginning of ROWs that have SCs on them to help give the STs some extra lift.

Color A = Outline. Color B = Shells. Carry unused yarn along the side of work.

With Color A, CH 51 (multiple of 8+3)

ROW 1: SC in 3<sup>rd</sup> CH from hook. SC in next 7 CHs. RPT [In next CH (SC, CH 1, SC). SC in next 7 CHs] across until CH. In last CH, 2 SC. Drop Color A. Turn.

ROW 2: Attach Color B. CH 2. Skip 4 STs. In next ST, 7 TR. RPT [Skip 4 STs. In CH-1 SP, SC. Skip 4 STs. In next ST, 7 TR] across, placing last SC in last ST. Drop Color B.

ROW 3: Bring up Color A and work in direction of ROW 2. SLST to top of CH-2. CH 2. RPT [SC in first 3 STs. On top of 4<sup>th</sup> ST (SC, CH 1, SC). SC in next 3 STs. SC in CH-1 from 2 ROWs below] across. Drop Color A. Turn.

ROW 4: Bring up Color B. CH 4. 3 TR in same ST. RPT [Skip 4 STs. SC in CH-1 SP. Skip 4 STs. 7 TR in next ST] across, replacing the last 7 TR with 4 TR in last ST. Drop Color B.

ROW 5: Bring up Color A. SLST to top of CH-4. CH 2. SC in next 3 STs. SC in CH-1 SP from 2 ROWs below. RPT [SC in next 3 STs. In next ST (SC, CH 1, SC). SC in next 3 STs. SC in CH-1 SP from 2 ROWs below] across until last 4 STs. SC in last 4 STs. Drop Color A. Turn.

RPT ROWs 2-5 for pattern.
