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Calla Lily Flower (Crochet)

This calla lily flower works up fast and easy and looks great in a bouquet as well as a vase. You can make them in any color too! Terminology:		
CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	HDC = Half Double Crochet
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch
SP = Space	ST = Stitch	TR = Treble Crochet

Gauge/Size:

3.5" W x 14" H. Gauge is not important.

Materials:

About 25 yards of worsted weight 100% dishcloth cotton yarn, or any other stiffer (not soft) worsted weight yarn in main color, and a few yards in a yellow color. Size F 3.75 mm crochet hook, preferably, to create smaller, tighter stitches. Size G 4 mm will also work if the F hook is too small. Wooden dowel ¼" in diameter x 12" in height, painted green. Scissors, yarn needle.

SPATHE (Orange/Red Section)

RND 1: CH 2. 8 HDC in 2nd CH from hook. SLST to first ST.

RND 2: CH 1 (does not count as a ST). 2 HDC in each ST around. SLST to first ST. Total = 16 STs.

RND 3: CH 1. RPT [2 HDC, HDC] around. SLST to first ST. Total = 24 STs. RND 4: CH 1. RPT [2 HDC, HDC, HDC] around. SLST to first ST. Total = 32 STs. RND 5: CH 1. RPT [2 HDC, HDC, HDC, HDC] around. SLST to first ST. Total = 40 STs. RND 6: CH 1. RPT [2 HDC, HDC, HDC, HDC, HDC] around, omitting last HDC in last ST. In last ST, [HDC, DC, TR, DC, HDC]. SLST to next ST. Fasten off, weave in ends.

SPADIX (Yellow Center Section)

CH 9.

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each ST across. CH 1, turn. Total = 8 STs. ROW 2: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: SC in each ST across. Fasten off, leaving a 12" tail end for sewing.

<u>FINISH</u>

Wrap SPADIX around green dowel. With 12" tail end, sew first row to third row, ensuring the top section is secured as well, so the dowel does not push through. Feel free to use a bit of hot glue to extra-secure the yellow section to the dowel. Once completed, wrap SPATHE around SPADIX and dowel. With matching yarn, sew a few stitches near the bottom to close that section, also catching a few stitches into the SPADIX. Fasten off and weave in all ends.
