Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	

Gauge/Size:

9"W x 8.5" H. Gauge is not important.

Materials:

About 100 yards of worsted weight 100% dishcloth cotton yarn in two colors. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Scissors, yarn needle.

Instructions:

Guidelines for mosaic crochet:

1) The chart's stitches can be read from right to left for right-handed crocheters or left to right for left-handed crocheters.

- 2) Read the chart starting from the bottom and work your way upwards.
- 3) Each block counts as 1 stitch across and 2 rows (upwards).
- 4) Carry the yarn up along the sides.
- 5) If the yarn color and block color are the same, make a single crochet.

6) If the yarn color and block color are different, make a chain 2 and skip a stitch. NOTE: Chain 2s count as 1 stitch going forward.

7) If the block contains an X in it, make 1 double crochet, 2 rows below, in front of the previous row's chain-2 stitches. On the subsequent read of the same blocks, change X blocks to single crochet stitches intead of double crochet ones.

8) Chain 1 and turn after completing each row.

9) Watch the tutorial video as it provides some tips and tricks for this particular style of mosaic crochet.

10) To begin, chain 34. Skip the first chain and begin the chart below.
