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The diamond granny stitch uses an easy double crochet pattern and turns it into diamonds by carrying yarn and making color changes. Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SLST = Slip Stitch	ST = Stitch

Traditional Granny Stitch Crochet Pattern

CH 25 (mult 3+1)

ROW 1: 2 DC in 4th CH from hook. RPT [Skip 2 CHs. 3 DC in next CH] across. Turn.

ROW 2: CH 3 (counts as DC). RPT [3 DC in next space] across. At the end, DC in turning CH-3. Turn.

ROW 3: CH 3 (counts as DC). 2 DC in adjacent space. RPT [Skip 2 CHs, 3 DC in next space] across. Turn.

RPT ROWs 2 & 3 for desired height.

Use the “Traditional Granny Stitch Crochet Pattern” above for the stitches. Follow the chart on the next page for where to make the color changes.



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
