



Crochet Easy Bow (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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This crochet easy bow pattern is simple and works up fast. This is a nice embellishment to put on your crochet items. Terminology:

CH = Chain

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

ST = Stitch

Size/Gauge

5"W x 4"H with worsted weight yarn and G 4 mm hook. 4"W x 3"H with DK weight yarn and an E 3.5 mm hook.

Materials

Less than 25 yards worsted weight yarn and a G 4 mm hook (larger bow), or less than 25 yards DK weight yarn with an E 3.5 mm hook. Optional bling or button for the center. Optional clear nail polish to secure the knots/ends.

LOOP SECTION

CH 36

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each CH across. Total = 35 STs.

ROW 2-6: CH 1, turn. SC in each ST across. Total = 35 STs.

Fasten off, leaving an 8" tail end. Sew shorter ends together, knot and/or weave in ends securely. Take another 8" piece of yarn and cinch and knot the center securely.

BOTTOM SECTION

CH 16

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each CH across. Total = 15 STs.

ROW 2: CH 1, turn. 2 SC in the first ST. SC across until the last ST. 2 SC in the last ST. Total = 17 STs.

ROWS 3-6: CH 1, turn. 2 SC in the first ST. SC across until the last ST. 2 SC in the last ST.

Fasten off. Take a 6" piece of yarn and cinch and knot the center securely.

FINISH

Cinch and knot the two pieces together (LOOP SECTION on top and BOTTOM SECTION on lower area). Secure knots tightly. Use drops of clear nail polish to secure knots if desired. Hot glue or sew on a button in the center as decoration
