



Granny Square (Crochet)

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Granny Square Crochet Tutorial. In this free pattern and video you will learn how to crochet a vintage granny square. Plus learn how to change colors and weave in ends as you go. Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

SC = Single Crochet

SP = Space

ST = Stitch

Instructions:

This pattern changes colors every RND. Crochet over tail ends to weave them in as you work. See video for tips and tricks on doing this.

With pink yarn, CH 6. SLST to form a ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC now and throughout). 2 DC in ring. CH 3. RPT [3 DC, CH 3] 3 times. SLST to top of CH 3. Fasten off.

RND 2: Place slipknot on hook with orange yarn. SLST to a corner-SP with it. CH 3. 2 DC in corner. CH 3. 3 DC in corner. CH 2 for side. RPT [(3 DC, CH 3, 3 DC) in corner. CH 2 for side] around. SLST to top of CH 3. Fasten off.

RND 3: Place slipknot on hook with yellow yarn. SLST to a corner-SP with it. CH 3. 2 DC in corner. CH 3. 3 DC in corner. CH 2, 3 DC in previous CH-2 SP. CH 2. RPT [(3 DC, CH 3, 3 DC) in corner. CH 2. 3 DC in previous CH-2 SP. CH 2.] around. SLST to top of CH 3. Fasten off.

RNDs 4+: Place slipknot on hook with blue yarn. Continue in pattern for corners. Increase sides as needed with CH-2s above previous 3 DCs, and 3 DC above previous CH-2s.

Final RND (BORDER): Place slipknot on hook with black yarn. SLST to a corner-SP with it. CH 1 (does not count as a ST). Place 3 SC in this corner (and in each corner around). Along each side, place 1 SC above each DC. Place 2 SC in each CH-2 SP. Once completed with all four sides, SLST to top of first SC. Fasten off.
