



Rose Flower Bouquet (Crochet)

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Crochet Rose Flower Bouquet. In this free pattern and video you will learn how to crochet a rose flower for a bouquet. Plus you'll learn how to add stems and leaves for a nice finish! Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	HDC = Half Double Crochet
RPT = Repeat	SLST = Slip Stitch	SC = Single Crochet
SP = Space	ST = Stitch	TR = Treble Crochet

Size/Gauge:

Flower is 4" in diameter by 4" height. Gauge is not important.

Materials:

About 30 yards of worsted weight yarn. Sample used 100% acrylic Crafter's Secret yarn. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Yarn needle. Wooden dowel for stem. Floral wire for leaves. Floral tape to wrap stem. Hot glue.

FLOWER

With green yarn, CH 33.

ROW 1: Skip 1 CH, HDC across. Total = 32 HDC. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: HDC across. Total = 32 HDC. Turn. Fasten off green yarn.

Place a slipknot on hook with pink yarn, SLST into first ST.

ROW 3: CH 1. 2 HDC across. Total = 64 HDC. Turn.

ROW 4: CH 4 (counts as 1 TR). Make 6 more TR in same SP. Skip 2 STs, SC in next ST. RPT [Skip 2 STs, 7 TR in next ST. Skip 2 STs, SC in next ST] across. Turn. CH 1.

ROW 5: SC in same SP. [RPT In the 7 TR shell, skip the first and last TR. Work 2 DC in each of the center 5 TR. SC in next SC] across, omitting the last SC. Fasten off and weave in ends.

LEAVES

With green yarn, CH 12.

SIDE 1: Skip 1st CH. Over the remaining CHs: SC, SC, HDC, HDC, DC, TR, DC, HDC, HDC, SC, SC. Pivot to work on SIDE 2.

SIDE 2: SC, SC, HDC, HDC, DC, TR, DC, HDC, HDC, SC, SC. Fasten off and weave in ends.

COMBINING

Test roll the flower to see how tight or loose you prefer it to be. Also check whether you want the last row of DC facing inwards or outwards for the petals.

Place a bit of hot glue on one end of the flower and immediately place the dowel in the glue. Let dry. Roll the flower along the dowel to form a 3D rose. Secure the flower in place with a yarn needle and matching yarn.

Cut 5" of floral wire and bend in half. Attach to the end of a leaf. Make as many of these leaves with wires as you prefer. Starting right underneath the flower, wrap floral tape tightly while moving down the stem. Incorporate the wires from the leaves into the wrapped tape. Fasten off and secure the ending.
