



Edging on Blanket Fabric (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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Crochet edging on blanket fabric tutorial shows how to make this pretty shell stitch along fleece fabric. Great for blankets! Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

SC = Single Crochet

SP = Space

ST = Stitch

Size/Gauge:

Size of blanket is customizable. Sample is 40" x 40". Gauge is not important.

Materials:

Fleece fabric – any size. About 150 yards of DK weight yarn for a 40" x 40" blanket. Size F 3.75 mm crochet hook. Sharp sewing needle, yarn needle, scissors. Optional matching embroidery floss.

Instructions:

Cut fleece fabric. Round out the corners. Sew a blanket stitch edging, either with yarn or matching embroidery floss, along all sides and corners. Keep in mind a multiple of 4 for the top loops of the blanket stitch.

Place a slipknot on hook. Insert into any top loop of the blanket stitch.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as DC). In same ST, DC, CH 2, 2 DC. Skip 3 STs. RPT [In next ST, 2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC, skip 3 STs] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

RNDs 2+: SLST over DC and into CH-2. CH 3 (counts as DC). In same ST, DC, CH 2, 2 DC. RPT [In next CH-2, 2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

LAST RND: SLST over DC and into CH-2. CH 3 (counts as DC). In same ST, DC, CH 3, SLST to first CH, 2 DC. RPT [In next CH-2, 2 DC, CH 3, SLST to first CH, 2 DC] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.
