



Bamboo Stitch (Tunisian Crochet)

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The Tunisian crochet bamboo stitch creates a nice texture and is easy to make. It combines Tunisian knit stitches with yarn pass overs to create the nice visual effect.

Terminology:

CH = Chain	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
ST = Stitch	TKS = Tunisian Knit Stitch	TSS = Tunisian Simple Stitch
YO = Yarn Over

CH 30 (mult of 3)

Setup Row: Skip the first CH, SC in each ST across. Total = 29 SC. Turn (do not CH)

ROW 1: Forward Pass - Draw up loops in each ST across as in TSS. Return Pass - CH 1, YO and take off loops in groups of 2 until 1 loop remains.

ROW 2: Forward Pass - RPT [YO, TKS in next 3 STs, pass YO over STs and off hook] across until last ST. In last ST, draw up a loop. Return Pass - CH 1, YO and take off loops in groups of 2 until 1 loop remains.

ROW 3: Forward Pass - TKS in each ST across. Return Pass - CH 1, YO and take off loops in groups of 2 until 1 loop remains.

RPT ROWs 2 & 3 until desired height.
