



Sideways Blanket Border Edging (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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Learn how to crochet the sideways blanket border edging pattern. This makes a beautiful blanket edging that can accommodate any stitch and size. Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

Terminology:

CH = Chain

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SLST = Slip Stitch

SP = Space

ST = Stitch

Instructions:

PREPARATION:

Place a SC border around your blanket. Start along a side, and end with a corner. Place 1 SC along each of the four sides and 3 SC STs in each of the four corners. SLST to first SC, which should be the first ST along a side. Do not fasten off yarn. Proceed to SIDE.

SIDE:

NOTES: This sample uses a starting CH of 6 along with 5 SC on each ROW. Feel free to begin with a different starting chain to increase or decrease the width of the

border. All SCs made in ROWs will be in the back loops. All SLSTs made are under both loops.

CH 6. SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each of the next 4 STs. Total = 5 SC. SLST into next ST along blanket to connect border. SLST into next ST to begin next ROW. Turn work.

OUTSIDE ROW: Skip both SLSTs and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SCs. CH 1, turn.

BLANKET ROW: Skip CH 1 and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SCs. SLST into next ST along blanket and SLST into next ST to begin next ROW. Turn work.

RPT *OUTSIDE ROW* and *BLANKET ROW*, ending with a *BLANKET ROW* right before the 3-SC CORNER.

CORNER:

ST #1: SLST into the first ST of the 3-SC CORNER. Turn work, elevate loop a bit. Skip SLST, and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. CH 1, turn. Skip CH 1, make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. SLST into ST #1. Turn work, elevate loop a bit. Skip SLST, and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. CH 1, turn. Skip CH 1, make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC.

ST #2: SLST into second ST of the 3-SC CORNER. Turn work. elevate loop a bit. Skip SLST, and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. CH 1, turn. Skip CH 1, make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. SLST into ST #2. Turn work, elevate loop a bit. Skip SLST, and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. CH 1, turn. Skip CH 1, make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC.

ST #3: SLST into third ST of the 3-SC CORNER. Turn work. elevate loop a bit. Skip SLST, and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. CH 1, turn. Skip CH 1, make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. SLST into ST #3. Turn work, elevate loop a bit. Skip SLST, and make 1 SC above each of the previous 5 SC. CH 1, turn.

Return to *BLANKET ROW* and *OUTSIDE ROW* repeats for second side.

Proceed with CORNER pattern for the remaining corners and SIDE pattern for the remaining sides.

Once completed, fasten off and leave an 8" tail end for sewing. Sew the beginning and ending sections closed. Weave in all ends.
