



Ribbon Stitch Pattern (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The crochet ribbon stitch pattern creates a nice textured woven look with single crochet and double crochet stitches. Easy to make too! Terminology:

CH = Chain

EDC = Elongated Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

CH 41 (mult 8+1)

ROW 1: With ivory yarn, SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each CH across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: With pink yarn, RPT [SC in next 4 STs, under both loops, SC in next 4 STs, under back loops only] across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: Continue with pink yarn. SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 4: With ivory yarn, RPT [SC in next 4 STs, back loops only. EDC in next 4 STs, using front loops from 2 rows below] across. At the end, SLST to top of last ST to secure EDC. CH 1, turn.

ROW 5: Continue with ivory yarn, SC across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 6: With pink (or another color) yarn, RPT [SC in next 4 STs, under back loops only, SC in next 4 STs, under both loops] across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 7: Continue with pink yarn. SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 8: With ivory yarn, RPT [EDC in next 4 STs, SC in next 4 STs, back loops only] across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 9: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

RPT ROWS 2-9 for as many rows as you wish.
