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Winter Hat (Crochet)

This Crochet Winter Hat makes a nice gift for yourself and others. It's quick and easy to make with two basic crochet stitches! Terminology:			
CH = Chain	SC = Single Crochet		ST = Stitch
RPT = Repeat			
Size/Gauge:			
Child, Women, Men		13 STs & 13 ROWs = 4" SQ	
Materials:			
200 yards worsted weight yarn. Sample used Crafters Secret 100% acrylic worsted			
weight yarn. Size H 5 mm hook. Yarn needle, measuring tape. Optional pompom.			
Instructions:

This sample is for an average women's size hat. Other sizes are listed below this main section of the pattern.			

CH 41. ROW 1: SC in each CH across, marking SC #12. CH 1, turn. ROW 2: RPT [Skip 1 ST, 2 SC in next ST] across until right before ST marker. For remaining 12 STs, SC in back loops, replacing ST marker. CH 1, turn. ROW 3: SC (back loops) in first 12 STs. Replace ST marker. For remaining STs, RPT [Skip 1 ST, 2 SC in next ST] across. CH 1, turn.

Measure work. Width of row should be 12 inches. Adjust as necessary to achieve this measurement.

RPT ROWs 2 & 3 for 66 rows or until measurement is 19-20 inches. This should then stretch to 22".

Fasten off, leaving a 12" tail end for sewing. With brim part facing the bottom, fold hat in half and seam the two sides together. Fasten off and weave in the ends.

With 2 strands of yarn and a yarn needle, cinch the top part of the hat, weaving in and out every 4 rows (to avoid a gap). Tie and knot securely, then weave in ends inside the hat.

Sew on a pompom if desired. Fasten off and weave in any remaining ends.

<u>Child's Size Hat</u> 180 yards of worsted weight yarn. CH 35. Each ROW will contain 10 SC for the brim. Width of row = 10-10.5". Make 59 ROWs or 17", which should stretch to 20".

<u>Men's Size Hat</u> 220 yards of worsted weight yarn. CH 43. Each ROW will contain 12 SC for the brim, but will have more stitches for the crown.

Make 72 ROWs or 21", which should stretch to 24".
