



## Mosaic Moss Stitch (Crochet)

The Crochet Mosaic Moss Stitch is a colorful pattern design that uses Mosaic Crochet techniques combined with single crochet and double crochet stitches. ### Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

SC = Single Crochet

ST = Stitch

RPT = Repeat

### Instructions:

Watch the YouTube tutorial video here: <https://youtube.com/naztazia> Look for "Crochet Mosaic Moss Stitch."

NOTE: Do not turn after each row. Start with a new yarn for every row, even if it's the same color. See video for an easy way to do color changes and weave in the starting and ending tail ends as you go.

CH 21 (or any odd #)

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each ST across. Fasten off work.

ROW 2: Begin a new yarn with a CH 1 and SC in starting ST under both loops. RPT [SC using back loops only] across until last ST. In last ST, SC under both loops. CH 1 to fasten off.

ROW 3: Begin a new yarn with a CH 1 and SC in starting ST under both loops. RPT [SC in back loop. In next ST, DC in front loop from 2 ROWs below] across. In last ST, SC under both loops. CH 1 to fasten off.

ROW 4: Begin a new yarn with a CH 1 and SC in starting ST under both loops. RPT [DC in front loop from 2 ROWs below. In next ST, SC in back loop] across. In last ST, SC under both loops. CH 1 to fasten off.

RPT ROWs 3 & 4.
