The Crochet Star Ornament is a lovely star shaped applique that works great any time of year, most especially at Christmas time on your tree. Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	HDC = Half Double Crochet
SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	ST = Stitch
RPT = Repeat	TR = Treble Crochet	

Size/Gauge:

About 4" from point to point. Gauge is not important

Materials:

About 30 yds worsted weight yarn. Sample used 100% acrylic in I Love This Yarn. Size G crochet hook (larger hook sizes will make a larger star). Yarn needle, scissors. Optional bling for center. Gold color yarn or thread for hanger.

CH 4. SLST to form ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). 14 DC in ring. SLST to top of CH-3. Total = 15 STs.

RND 2: RPT [CH 6. SC in 3rd CH from hook. HDC in next CH. DC in next CH. TR in next CH. Skip 2 STs and SLST in 3rd ST from base of CH] around for a total of 5 points.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew or glue bling to the center. Add an ornament hanger with gold or other suitable yarn.
