



## Curly Wreath Ornament (Crochet)

### Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

### Size/Gauge:

About 4.5" in diameter. Gauge is not important

### Materials:

About 20 yds worsted weight yarn (10 red and 10 green). Sample used 100% acrylic yarn from Mainstays. Size G 4- or 4.25-mm crochet hook. Yarn needle, scissors. Optional bow and bling for decoration.

### Instructions:

Make 2 Curlicues (sample make 1 green one and 1 red one)

CH 45.

Skip 3 CHs (counts as 1 DC) and make 3 DC in 4<sup>th</sup> CH from hook. Total = 4 DC. RPT 4 DC in each CH across. At the end, fasten off, leaving a 5" tail end.

Place the two ending tail ends together and have both spirals face the same direction. Begin to twist them together, adjusting the coils as needed.

Once completed, join the two ends together to form a circle and wreath shape, using any of the following methods: 1) hot glue the ends together or 2) tie and knot the beginning and ending tail ends together or 3) sew the two ends together. Once completed, fasten off and weave in ends.

Sew or hot glue an optional bow and bling to your wreath. Add a yarn strand for the hanger section.
