



# Spiral Dishcloth (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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This crochet spiral dishcloth looks great in the kitchen and bath. This scrubbie is easy to make using two colors and has a great look to it! ## Terminology:

CH = Chain	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
ST= Stitch	YO = Yarn Over	

## Size/Gauge:

About 6 inches in diameter. Gauge is not important.

## Supplies:

30 yards total of 100% cotton worsted weight yarn (15 yards one color, 15 another). Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Yarn needle, scissors, stitch markers.

## Instructions:

Make a separate magic or padded ring (see video for how-to). Use stitch markers to hold unused loops. Sample used Color A (blue yarn) and Color B (yellow yarn).

### RND 1:

Place a slipknot on the hook with Color A (blue). In ring, (SC, HDC, 4 DC). Remove hook from loop. Place a slipknot on hook with Color B (yellow). In ring, (SC, HDC, 4 DC). Pull separate strands of magic/padded ring to close the center securely. Tie, knot, weave in ends.

### RND 2:

Switch to Color A. 2 DC over each of the 6 yellow STs. Mark first blue ST. (12 STs).

Switch to Color B. 2 DC over each of the next 6 blue STs, stopping before ST marker. (12 STs)

RND 3:

Switch to Color A. (2 DC in next ST, DC in next) over the next yellow STs. Mark first blue ST. (18 STs).

Switch to Color B. (2 DC in next ST, DC in next) over the next blue STs, stopping before ST marker. (18 STs)

RND 4:

Switch to Color A. (2 DC in next ST, DC in next, DC in next) over the next yellow STs. Mark first blue ST. (24 STs).

Switch to Color B. (2 DC in next ST, DC in next, DC in next) over the next blue STs, stopping before ST marker (24 STs). Continue to TAPER.

TAPER:

Continue with Color B: HDC in next ST, HDC in next, SC in next, SC in next, SLST in next. Fasten off yellow yarn.

Switch to Color A: HDC in next ST, HDC in next, SC in next, SC in next, SLST in next. Continue to EDGING.

EDGING:

Continue with Color A: SC in next ST. CH 10 (or any number for loop). SC in next ST. Around entire cloth, CH 1, SC in next ST. Fasten off and weave in ends.
