This crochet v-stitch cluster stitch pattern looks great in a blanket, hat, scarf, and more. It's easy to do and quick to make! Terminology:

CH = Chain

PREV = Previous

RPT = Repeat

ST= Stitch

YO = Yarn Over

DC-CL = Double Crochet Cluster. YO, insert hook into ST, YO, draw up loop, YO, remove 2 loops. YO, insert hook into same ST, YO, draw up loop, YO, remove 2 loops. YO, remove remaining 3 loops.

Instructions:

CH 26 (mult 3+2)

ROW 1: (DC-CL, CH 1, DC-CL) in 4th CH from hook. RPT [SK 2 CH, (DC-CL, CH 1, DC-CL) in next ST] across. In last ST, DC. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: (DC-CL, CH 1, DC-CL) in each CH-1 from the PREV row across. DC in last DC. CH 3, turn.

ROWS 3+ RPT ROW 2.
