



3D Wave Stitch (Crochet)

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The Crochet 3D Wave Stitch Pattern produces a nice textured look in your work. Use this for your next blanket, scarf, bag, and more! Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

FPDC = Front Post Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SP = Space

ST= Stitch

Instructions:

CH 33 (multiple of 3)

ROW 1: DC in 5th CH from hook. DC in each ST across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: 3 DC in next ST. RPT [CH 3, skip 2 STs, 3 DC in next ST] across. At the end, place a DC in the top of the turning CH-3 from previous row. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3: RPT [3 FPDC in third ST of previous row's 3-DC. CH 3] across. At the end, place a DC in the top of the turning CH-3 from previous row.

RPT ROW 3, substituting “previous row’s 3-FPDC” for “previous row’s 3-DC.”

LAST ROW: RPT ROW 3, omitting the CH-3s in between. Fasten off and weave in ends.
