



Layered Shell Stitch (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The Crochet Layered Shell Stitch pattern creates a nice 3D look to your work. This one looks great for a blanket as well as with clothing! Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SP = Space

ST= Stitch

TR = Treble Crochet

Instructions:

With light pink yarn, CH 27 (multiple 8+3)

ROW 1: DC in 4th CH from hook. DC across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: DC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: All STs will be made in the front-front loop and the front loop. Leave the back loops unworked. SC in first ST. RPT [Skip 3 STs. 7 TR in next ST. Skip 3 STs. SC in next ST] across, placing the last SC in the top of the turning CH-3. Fasten off yarn. DO NOT turn work.

With medium pink yarn, place a slipknot on hook.

ROW 1: Work in previously unworked back loops of light pink yarn's ROW 3. Fold down shell ROW. SLST in first ST. CH 3. DC in each ST across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: DC in each ST across (using both loops as usual). CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: RPT ROW 3 of light pink yarn. Fasten off yarn.

Continue repeating ROWs 1, 2, and 3 of medium pink yarn until desired height.
