

RND 1: In $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{CH}$, make 11 DC. (Skipped CH-3 counts as 1 DC). Total = 12 DC. SLST to first ST to close ring. Fasten off yellow yarn.

With pink yarn, place a slipknot on hook. STs will be worked in the two back loops of each DC from RND 1.

RND 2:
EACH PETAL - SC in any ST. CH 5. Skip 1 CH , SC in remaining 4 CHs. CH 1, SLST to initial SC. SC in next ST (creates a ST in between petals).
RPT around to create 6 PETALs. Continue with same yarn.
RND 3:
EACH PETAL - SLST to initial SC. Along the 4 SCs from previous RND (SC, HDC, DC, 4 $D C$ ). The 4 DC counts as 3 DC along the side and 1 DC along the top. Working on the other side of the 4 SCs from previous RND (3 DC, DC, HDC, SC). Skip CH-1. SLST to SC in between PETALs.
RPT around to finalize all 6 PETALs. After sixth PETAL, fasten off and weave in ends.
