



Flower Power Blossom (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The Crochet Flower Power Blossom has a late 1960s early 1970s vibe to it. Made with colorful yarn, these flowers work up fast and easy! Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

HDC = Half Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SLST = Slip Stitch

SP = Space

ST= Stitch

Size/Gauge:

Size = 4.5" diameter. Gauge is not important.

Supplies:

Less than 30 yards worsted weight yarn in two colors. Sample used Premiere Home Cotton yarn in various colors. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Sewing needle, scissors.

Instructions:

With yellow yarn, CH 4.

RND 1: In 4th CH, make 11 DC. (Skipped CH-3 counts as 1 DC). Total = 12 DC. SLST to first ST to close ring. Fasten off yellow yarn.

With pink yarn, place a slipknot on hook. STs will be worked in the two back loops of each DC from RND 1.

RND 2:

EACH PETAL – SC in any ST. CH 5. Skip 1 CH, SC in remaining 4 CHs. CH 1, SLST to initial SC. SC in next ST (creates a ST in between petals).

RPT around to create 6 PETALS. Continue with same yarn.

RND 3:

EACH PETAL – SLST to initial SC. Along the 4 SCs from previous RND (SC, HDC, DC, 4 DC). The 4 DC counts as 3 DC along the side and 1 DC along the top. Working on the other side of the 4 SCs from previous RND (3 DC, DC, HDC, SC). Skip CH-1. SLST to SC in between PETALS.

RPT around to finalize all 6 PETALS. After sixth PETAL, fasten off and weave in ends.
