Terminology:		
CH = Chain	RPT = Repeat	SLST = Slip Stitch
ST= Stitch		

Supplies:

Less than 20 yards of worsted weight (medium weight) yarn. Sample used 100% acrylic. Size G 4- or 4.25-mm crochet hook. Yarn needle and scissors. Optional bead, button, bling, pompom for the center of the flower and hot glue.

Size/Gauge:

Size is 3" in diameter. Gauge is not important.

Instructions:

Make a slipknot.

RPT [CH 15. SLST into first CH.] 18 times.

After the last loop, leave a 12" tail end and fasten off the work.

Roll the loops along the SLST edge to form a flower shape. Using the 12" tail end and a yarn needle, make a few STs to secure the flower.

Hot glue a mini pompom or gem to the center or sew a button or bead to the center. Weave in all ends.
