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## Shell Ripple Stitch (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The crochet shell ripple stitch pattern works great for a blanket and other items. Changing colors every two rows creates the chevron design! Terminology:		
CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	ST= Stitch	
DC4TOG = Double Crochet Four Together		
DC5TOG = Double Crochet Five Together		
DC9TOG = Double Crochet Nine Together		
Instructions:		

CH 34 (multiple 8+2)

ROW 1: SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook. RPT [Skip 3 CHs, 9 DC in next CH. Skip 3 CHs, SC in next CH) across. Turn. Change to a new color.

ROW 2: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). DC4TOG, CH 1 to close. CH 3, SC in top of shell. RPT [CH 3, DC9TOG, CH to close, CH 3, SC in top of shell] across until you cannot make any more DC9TOG. On the last shell, make a DC5TOG, using the remaining 4 STs from the shell and the last SC from the previous row. CH 1 to close the ST. CH 1 and turn, using same color yarn.

ROW 3: SC in previous together-ST. RPT [9 DC in next SC. SC in next together-ST] across. Turn. Change colors.

RPT ROWs 2 & 3 until desired size.

End on a ROW 2 for a straight edge. End on a ROW 3 for a ripple edge. Fasten off and weave in all ends.
