



# Rolled Rose Edging (Crochet)

## Terminology:

CH = Chain

HDC = Half Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST= Stitch

## Instructions:

CH 22 (stitch multiple of 7+1).

Place a slipknot on hook. SC directly into first ST of edging.

ROSE:

CH 7. Skip 2 CHs. 4 HDC in next CH and in each remaining CH. Remove crochet hook. Pivot work so loop is facing the hand you crochet with. Twist the other section of the work into a flower shape. Insert crochet hook back into loop, and pierce through all layers of the flower. SLST to connect. Then immediately make 1 SC in each of the next 6 STs. Then go back and readjust the flower as needed.

RPT the ROSE instructions for as many flowers as you wish, ending with a flower and its SLST if working on just the one side.
