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V-Neck Collar (Crochet)

This crochet v-neck collar dresses up your plain tops and t-shirts. It is made with a granny square and extended granny stitch pattern. 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CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch

Materials:

100 yds fine/sport weight yarn in any fiber. Crochet thread size 3 also works. Sample used Yarn Art Begonia. Size C 2.75 mm crochet hook. Sewing needle and matching thread. Optional bling for bottom of collar.

Size/Gauge:

Sample collar is 2" W x 11" L. Pattern can be adjusted to accommodate other sizes,

Instructions:

CENTER

CH 6. SLST to first CH to form ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC throughout pattern). 2 DC in ring. CH 3. RPT [3 DC in ring, CH 3] 3 times. SLST to first ST. Total = 4 sets of 3 DC with 4 CH-3s in each corner.

RND 2: SLST over 2 STs and into corner. CH 3. 2 DC in SP. CH 3. 3 DC in same SP. CH 1. RPT [In next SP, 3 DC, CH 3, 3 DC. CH 1] around. SLST to first ST. SLST over next 2 STs and in corner. Prepare to work in ROWs. Use same thread/yarn. Turn work.

FIRST SIDE

ROW 1: CH 3. 2 DC in same SP. CH 1. In next SP, 3 DC. CH 1. In last SP, 3 DC. Turn work.

ROW 2: CH 3. CH 1. In next SP, 3 DC. CH 1. In next SP, 3 DC. CH 1. DC in last ST. Turn work.

RPT ROWs 1 & 2 to accommodate shirt. Sample shirt went to shoulder seam. Other options include meeting at the back of the neck. Fasten off work.

SECOND SIDE

Place slipknot on hook with new thread/yarn. SLST to center of V, in the SP where FIRST SIDE's ROW 1 began.

ROW 1: CH 3. 2 DC in same SP. CH 1. In next SP, 3 DC. CH 1. In last SP, 3 DC. Turn work.

ROW 2: CH 3. CH 1. In next SP, 3 DC. CH 1. In next SP, 3 DC. CH 1. DC in last ST. Turn work.

RPT ROWs 1 & 2 to accommodate other side of shirt. Match the number of ROWs as FIRST SIDE (unless you prefer an asymmetrical look). Fasten off work.

Place V collar on v-neck shirt. With a sewing needle and thread, sew collar to shirt along top edge only (the bottom edge should lay flat and not need sewing). Sew along both shoulder edges (or back of neck). Fasten off work. Weave in all ends.
