



Woven Dishcloth (Crochet)

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The crochet woven dishcloth is a cute, colorful, and practical item for your kitchen. Four simple sections are woven together with slip stitches. Terminology:

CH = Chain	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch

Materials:

50 yds worsted weight yarn. Sample used Premier Cotton yarn. Size H 5 mm and G 4 mm crochet hook. Yarn needle, scissors.

Size/Gauge:

Finished size is 3" x 3". Gauge is not important.

Instructions:

STRIPE #1 (green in the sample)

With size H crochet hook, CH 23. (Larger CHs prevent puckering in the finished item).

ROW 1: Change over to size G crochet hook. SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each CH across.

ROWS 2-6: CH 1, turn. SC in each ST across.

Bring short ends together and SLST to connect into a ring. Fasten off and weave in ends.

STRIPE #2 (blue in the sample)

Follow CH 23 and ROWs 1-6 as STRIPE #1

Bring short ends together, going through STRIPE #1's ring, and SLST to connect into a ring. Fasten off and weave in ends.

STRIPE #3 (pink in the sample)

Follow CH 23 and ROWs 1-6 as STRIPE #1

Bring short ends together, going through STRIPE #2's ring, and SLST to connect into a ring. Fasten off and weave in ends.

STRIPE #4 (orange in the sample)

Follow CH 23 and ROWs 1-6 as STRIPE #1

Bring short ends together, going through STRIPE #3's ring. Turn dishcloth over and weave end through STRIPE #1's ring, then SLST to connect into a ring. Fasten off and weave in ends.
