

## **Terminology:**

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	HDC = Half Double Crochet
SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space
ST = Stitch	RPT = Repeat	

## Instructions:

CH 26 (mult 4+2)

ROW 1: DC in 4<sup>th</sup> CH from hook. DC in each CH across. CH 3, turn. Total = 24 STs.

ROW 2: DC in each ST across. CH 1 (does not count as a ST), turn.

ROW 3: HDC in first 6 STs. CH 4, turn. SLST in 4<sup>th</sup> ST from hook. CH 2, turn. Make 8 DC in CH-4 SP. RPT [HDC in next 4 STs. CH 4, turn. SLST through SP next to and underneath previous shell. CH 2, turn. 8 DC in CH-4 SP] across, until last 2 ST. Make 1 HDC in each of last 2 STs. CH 3 (counts as 1 DC), turn.

ROW 4: DC in 2<sup>nd</sup> ST. Under each shell, make 4 DC STs. DC in each of last 2 STs. CH 3 (counts as 1 DC), turn. Total = 24 STs.

ROW 5: DC in each ST across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 6: DC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

RPT ROWs 3, 4, 5 & 6.
