## Size/Gauge:

Finished size is 5.5" in diameter. Gauge is not important.

## **Materials:**

For each wreath, 30 yds worsted weight yarn. The green wreath sample used 100% acrylic yarn in green and a small amount in white. Size G 4 mm crochet hook. Scissors, yarn needle. One 2.75-inch bracelet or other round item. Optional ribbon bow.

## Instructions:

RND 1: Place slipknot on hook with green yarn. SC in ring. Make 49 more SC in ring. Total = 50 SC. If using a size other than 2.75 inches, make an even number of SC in ring. SLST to close ring.

RND 2: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). DC in each ST around. Total = 50 DC. SLST to close ring. Continue to EDGING with green yarn.

## EDGING:

CH 6 with green yarn. Remove hook and place green CH-6 forward. With white yarn, place slipknot on hook and SLST to next ST, going behind green yarn. CH 6 with white yarn. Remove hook and place white CH-6 forward. Place hook in green yarn and SLST to next ST, going behind the white yarn. CH 6 with green yarn. Remove hook and place green CH-6 forward. Place hook in white yarn and SLST to next ST behind the green yarn. CH 6 with white yarn. Continue in this pattern around, ending with the last green yarn CH-6, fasten off and pull through, leaving a 6-inch tail end. Place a white SLST in last ST, then CH 6 with white yarn, fasten off and pull through, leaving a 6-inch tail end.

Curl the green CH-6 over towards the back and weave in ends. Curl the white CH-6 over towards the back and weave in ends.

Fasten off any remaining ends. Sew or glue on optional ribbon bow.



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
