



## Daisy Granny Square (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The crochet daisy granny square is made like a traditional granny square except it has a pretty colorful flower in the center! ### Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	SC = Single Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch
RPT = Repeat	TR = Treble Crochet	

### Size/Gauge:

Size is 4.5" x 4.5". Gauge is not important.

### Materials:

50 yds total of 100% acrylic worsted weight yarn in several colors. Size G 4 mm crochet hook or any comfortable size for the yarn. Yarn sewing needle.

### Instructions:

With yellow yarn, CH 4. SLST to form ring.

RND 1: CH 1. RPT [SC in ring, CH 4] 8 times. SLST to first ST. Total = 8 loops. Fasten off yellow yarn.

RND 2: Place slipknot on hook with white yarn. For each petal, RPT [SLST in loop. CH 3. 2 TR. CH 3, SLST in loop] CH 1 in between petals. After last petal, CH 1 and SLST to first ST. Total = 8 petals. Fasten off white yarn.

PRE-RND 3: Place slipknot on hook with green yarn. RPT [SC in CH-1 SP between petals. CH 4. Push next petal forward so CH-4 is behind petal]. Total = 8 back loops. Continue with green yarn.

RND 3: From now on, a traditional “granny square” pattern is followed. SLST to next loop. For this RND, alternate making a CORNER in the loop and then a SIDE in the next loop. First CORNER: In first loop, CH 3. 2 DC. CH 2. 3 DC. SIDE: In second loop, 3 DC. Second CORNER: In third loop, 3 DC, CH 2, 3 DC. Second SIDE: In fourth loop, 3 DC. Continue in pattern to create 4 CORNERS and 4 SIDES. SLST to first ST.

RND 4: SLST over to CORNER. In first CORNER, CH 3. 2 DC. CH 2. 3 DC. The next SIDE consists of 3 DC in first SP and 3 DC in next SP. In second CORNER, 3 DC. CH 2. 3 DC. For second SIDE, 3 DCs in first SP and 3 DC in next SP. Continue creating 2 more CORNERS with 2 more SIDES. SLST to first ST. Fasten off green yarn.

RND 5: Place a slipknot on hook with blue yarn. SLST to CORNER. Follow RND 4’s CORNER pattern. For each SIDE on RND 5, there will be 3 sets of 3 DC. SLST to first ST. Fasten off green yarn and weave in all ends.
