



# Brioche Stitch (Crochet)

The crochet brioche stitch pattern is similar to the knitted version. Double slip stitches create the colorful 3D effect. ## Terminology:

CH = Chain

SP = Space

ST = Stitch

RPT = Repeat

DSLST = Double Slip Stitch

YO = Yarn Over

## Instructions:

Double Slip Stitch (DSLST) = YO, insert hook into ST, YO, pull loop through ST and remaining 2 loops on hook.

NOTE: Change colors every row. Carry unused yarn across work and crochet over it.

With pink, CH 21 for a sample. No multiples in this stitch pattern.

ROW 1: DSLST in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook and in each CH across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: DSLST along front (bottom) loop of side CH-like STs from the row below. CH 1, turn.

RPT ROW 2 for pattern.
