



## Granny Square Fluted Edge (Crochet)

This crochet granny square fluted edging works on blankets, scarves, and shawls. The pattern consists of v-stitches and double crochet. ### Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	FPDC = Front Post Double Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch
RPT = Repeat		

### Instructions:

This works for a traditional granny square motif.

RND 1:

SIDES: Make a slipknot on hook and attach it via a SC to a CH-SP along one side of the granny square. Make another SC on top of that SC (stackable SCs are an alternative to the first DC). CH 2. DC in space SP. For all other side spaces, RPT [DC, CH 2, DC]. These v-stitches will be made on all four sides. Proceed to CORNER instructions as needed.

**CORNERS:** In each corner, make 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC. Each corner will have the 4 double crochet stitches with the 3 CH-2s in between. It appears that 3 v-stitches have been melded together.

When RND 1 has been completed, SLST to the top of the first (alternative) DC.

RND 2:

**SIDES:** CH 2. In each v-stitch from the previous RND, make 1 FPDC around the first leg of the previous v-stitch. 3 DC in the previous CH-2 SP. 1 FPDC around the second leg of the previous v-stitch. Proceed to CORNER instructions as needed.

**CORNERS:** As a reminder there are 4 DC in each corner with 3 CH-2 SPs in between. In each corner, 1 FPDC around the first leg of the previous v-stitch. 3 DC in the first CH-2 SP. 1 FPDC around the second leg of the previous v-stitch. 3 DC in the second CH-2 SP. 1 FPDC around the third leg of the previous v-stitch. 3 DC in the third CH-2 SP. 1 FPDC around the last leg of the previous v-stitch.

When RND 2 has been completed, SLST to the top of the first ST. Fasten off and weave in ends.
