



Granny Square Tree (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

SC = Single Crochet

SP = Space

ST = Stitch

Size/Gauge:

Finished size (including stick and pompom) 7" x 3.5." Granny square 5" x 5."

Supplies:

50 yards total of 100% acrylic worsted weight yarn for the granny square. Sample green tree used a light green, medium green, and dark green. Size H 5 mm crochet hook. Sewing needle, scissors. Hot glue, 6" x 3/4" craft stick, 1.25" pompom.

Instructions:

With light green yarn, CH 4. SLST to form a ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC now and throughout). 2 DC in ring. CH 2. RPT [3 DC, CH 2] 3 times. SLST to top of CH 3. Fasten off light green yarn.

RND 2: Place slipknot on hook with medium green yarn. SLST to a corner-SP with it. CH 3. 2 DC in corner. CH 2. 3 DC in corner. CH 1 for side. RPT [(3 DC, CH 2, 3 DC) in corner. CH 1 for side] around. SLST to top of CH 3.

RND 3: SLST over to corner-SP. CH 3. 2 DC in corner. CH 2. 3 DC in corner. CH 1, 3 DC in previous CH-1 SP. CH 1. RPT [(3 DC, CH 2, 3 DC) in corner. CH 1. 3 DC in previous CH-1 SP. CH 1.] around. SLST to top of CH 3. Fasten off.

RND 4: Place slipknot on hook with dark green yarn. SLST to a corner-SP with it. Continue in pattern for corners. Increase sides as needed with CH-1s above previous 3 DCs, and 3 DC above previous CH-1s.

RND 5: Continue in pattern with dark green yarn. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Turn granny square over so reverse side is facing upwards. Insert stick into a last RND corner, fold up end and hot glue to the stick. Fold both right and left corners downwards to meet point at bottom and hot glue in place. Hot glue pompom to top of tree.
