



Heart Basket (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

The crochet heart basket uses a wooden base template with pre-drilled holes for crocheting. This makes it very easy to make a heart! Terminology:

CH = Chain

SC = Single Crochet

SLST = Slip Stitch

SP = Space

ST = Stitch

RPT = Repeat

Supplies

One 10-inch heart wooden base template. 75 yards of t-shirt yarn. Sample used Batelo T-shirt in pink. Crochet hook size K 6.5, or any size that can fit through the pre-drilled holes. Optional felt or fabric to line bottom of basket. Scissors, yarn needle.

Instructions:

Optional: use the heart wooden template before beginning to trace around felt or fabric for lining the bottom of the basket.

Make a loose slipknot on the hook and make a SC into a SP next to the bottom point (leaving the bottom SP for last). Make 1 SC in each ST around one side of the heart, stopping before the middle 3 top SPs.

Make a single crochet 3 together over the middle 3 top SPs. Make 1 SC in each ST around the other side of the heart, stopping before bottom point.

At the bottom point, make 3 SC in it. SLST to the first SC.

RNDs 2-7: CH 1. Make 1 SC in each ST around.

After last RND, add an optional border, such as the braided edge, consisting of CH 1, SLST in next ST, CH 1, SLST in next ST, CH 1, SLST in next ST around.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.
