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Glasses Holder (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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This crochet glasses holder is cute in both the dog and cat version. It makes finding eyeglasses much easier! Terminology:		
CH = Chain	HDC = Half Double Crochet	SC = Single Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch
SC2TOG = Single Crochet 2 Together		RPT = Repeat

Supplies

100 yards of worsted weight yarn. Sample used Big Twist Value in a variety of colors. Crochet hook size H 5 mm, or any comfortable size. Optional pieces of felt. Scissors, yarn needle.

NOTE: USE 2 STRANDS of yarn held together

BASE

Slipknot and CH 14.

RND 1: 3 HDC in 2nd CH from hook. Mark 1st and 3rd HDC. HDC in next 11 CHs. 3 HDC in last CH. Mark 1st and 3rd HDC. Working on other side of CH, HDC in next 11 CHs. SLST to close RND.

RND 2: CH 1. 2 HDC in next 3 STs. Mark 1st and last HDC. HDC in next 11 STs. 2 HDC in next 3 STs. Mark 1st and last HDC. HDC in next 11 STs. SLST to close RND.

RND 3: CH 1. In the area of marked STs, [2 HDC, HDC] 3 times. Mark 1st and last HDC. HDC in next 11 STs. In the area of marked STs, [2 HDC, HDC] 3 times. Mark 1st and last HDC. HDC in next 11 STs. SLST to close RND.

RND 4: CH 1. In the area of marked STs. [2 HDC, HDC, HDC] 3 times. Mark 1st and last HDC. HDC in next 11 STs. In the area of marked STs, [2 HDC, HDC, HDC] 3 times. Mark 1st and last HDC. HDC in next 11 STs. SLST to close RND.

Fold work in half to find center. Mark center top and bottom.

RND 5: Turn work and CH 1. SLST to center, (count that #), SLST in center, and SLST the prev #. HDC in remaining STs around. SLST to CH-1 and leave a 15-inch tail end for sewing snout.

SNOUT

Slipknot and CH 2.

RND 1: 6 HDC in 2nd CH from hook. SLST to close. CH 1.

RND 2: 2 HDC in each ST around. SLST to close. CH 1.

RND 3: HDC around. SLST to close and fasten off.

EYES & NOSE

Use sticky-back felt circles or triangles for the nose and eyes. Or embroidery with yarn. Sew SNOUT onto BASE using 15-inch tail end.

DOG EARS

NOTE: Instead of CH-1s at the beginning of ROWs, lift loop higher and proceed with SC.

First Ear -

ROW 1: Count 7 over from top center ST marker. Place slipknot on hook and SC in 7th ST from center. SC in next 5 STs (total = 6 SC). Turn.

ROWs 2-10: SC in each ST across. Turn.

ROW 11: SC2TOG over first 2 STs. SC in next 2 STs. SC2TOG over last 2 STs. Turn.

ROW 12: SC in each ST across. Fasten off work, leaving an 8-inch tail end to attach to side of holder.

The second ear is started 2 STs away from the ST marker.

CAT EARS

NOTE: Instead of CH-1s at the beginning of ROWs, lift loop higher and proceed with SC.

First Ear -

ROW 1: Count 7 over from top center. Place slipknot on hook and SC in 7^{th} ST from center. SC in next 5 STs (total = 6 SC). Turn.

ROW 2: SC in each ST across. Turn.

ROW 3: SC2TOG over first 2 STs. SC in next 2 STs. SC2TOG over last 2 STs. Turn.

ROW 4: SC in each ST across. Turn.

ROW 5: SC2TOG over first 2 STs. SC2TOG over last 2 STs. Turn.

ROW 6: SC in each ST across. Fasten of work.

Use 15-inch tail end of base to attach the snout to the bottom of the base over the SLSTs.

The second ear is started 2 STs away from the ST marker.

Weave in all ends.
